Discover the charm and fascinating history of Kristinehamn during a guided tour or a walk of your own. Stay a little longer and discover even more.

FIVE QUICK FACTS ON KRISTINEHAMN

1. Practically all the baking tins used in Swedish bakeries are made by Siluette of Sweden here in Kristinehamn.
2. Since 1937 Kongsberg Maritime have manufactured and delivered over 8 000 propeller systems to ships all over the world.
3. Kristinehamn is located by Lake Vänern, the third largest lake in Europe, with a large archipelago. It offers beautiful nature and some of the best trolling fishing in the area.
4. The world's biggest Picasso sculpture was built in Kristinehamn 60 years ago, thanks to the artist Bengt Olson.
5. At Atley Solutions, groundbreaking technology for the future of cancer treatment is developed and manufactured.

POINTS OF INTEREST ALONG THE WALK

Walk along the Varnan waterway into the Age of Iron, on the same streets as on the 17th-century maps. Stroll through the heart of the town, where the old wooden houses and maritime heritage meet.

GUIDING SIGNS THE OLD TOWN

City Walk on your own
Follow the nine signs and get an insight into the settings and events that were important for Kristinehamn's development. The walk takes about 30 min.

1 VÅGEN BLOCK

A place bursting with history

Hovslagareg. / S. Hamng.

Kristinehamn was a trading and maritime town. Here in Vågen block you are reminded of the town's important role as the Iron town. Most of the houses in this block are from the time after the fire of 1804.

1A WAHLUNDSGÅRDEN

A gem from the 1800s

Västerlångg 22. Built 1806.

Wahlundsgården is a fine example of what a townhouse looked like in the 1700s and 1800s. This is where the merchant Gustaf Wahlund lived, after whom the estate is named. The main building along with the stable blocks enclosed a leafy courtyard. Today you will find several interesting places to visit here, such as Kristinehamn's Museum of History, the Picture Archive, Retrovågen and several flea markets. Take a seat on the colourful garden furniture and enjoy the beautiful inner courtyard.

1B SJÖTULLEN

The stylish Custom House

Hovslagareg 6.

The Custom House is a fine example of Swedish classic architecture and was built after the fire of 1804. The man who built it, Johan Carl Garneij, was not only a lawyer but also a prominent scientist and author. The real customs house lay nearer the river bank and that is where the Lake

Customs used to be housed. That building was demolished in 1889.

2 THE GALLEY MATILDA

Kristinehamn's maritime history

Vågparken. Built 1965.

In the park you will find a miniature of the Galley Matilda, one of the first cargo vessels that Axels Broström's Group used. The work, created by Carl-Emil Berglin, is a reminder of the town's historical connection to shipping.

3 NORDENFELDTSKA

The town's oldest stone house

Norra Hamng 8. Built 1771.

This was previously the site of Duke Charles IX's Royal Estate. He lived here when he visited Bro. Fru Regina Nordenfeldt built Kristinehamn's first stone house directly on the foundations of one of the wings. The citizens saw the advantage of building in stone when the city burned in 1777.

4 JÄRNVÅGEN - THE IRON SCALE

Weighing history

Vågparken. Built 1991.

A copy of the old Iron Weightscale stands here in the park, where the iron was once weighed before it was shipped out of town. A reminder of the time when Kristinehamn was a centre for iron trading. The fee for weighing the iron on the scale was the town's largest source of income for many years.

CITY FIRES

Many wooden towns were reduced to ashes due to fires.

In just over one hundred years (1777 – 1893) Kristinehamn suffered three major city fires.

5 BRIDGE VÅGBRON

An important link in the city **Västerlånggatan. Built 1875.** The Bridge (Swedish word Bro) has been a central part of the town's history. Kristinehamn was once called Bro before it became a city. Some say this was because the bridge was an important meeting place along the old national road between Sweden and Norway.

The bridge has been rebuilt several times over the years, at one point when Sjöändan Railway laid a track over the bridge to the loading dock at Sjötullen (the Lake Customs). However, as the burden became too great the bridge was rebuilt again in 1875.

6 THE TOWNHALL (RÅDHUSET)

A symbol for Kristinehamn

Kungsgatan 25. Built 1805. After the fire of 1777 Kristinehamn's new town hall was built on the same spot as the old one. The drawings, which were approved by King Gustav IV Adolf, led to the construction of a stylish building.

7 TRÄDGÅRDSGATAN

Atmosphere and history
One of the town's most picturesque streets offers a charming 1700s ambiance. There are beautiful old wooden houses here and you experience a feeling of history as you walk along cobbled streets. The name Trädgårdsgatan, Garden Street, was given because the house owners laid out gardens as firewalls by the waterway Varnan. The gardens were later donated to the town, now Nordenfeldt Park, which makes the area even more lovely.

8 GRUNDELSGÅRDEN

One of the town's oldest and most beautiful houses

Trädgårdsgatan 2.

The building is one of the town's most impressive older townhouses, built after the fire of 1777. The Grundel family owned the house from 1891 and it served as the office for the local newspaper Nya Kristinehamnsposten until 1929. Today it is a dwelling house, but the atmosphere of the past is still there.

9 ISBERGSGÅRDEN

A building with a long history

Fabriksgatan 21.

The house was built after the fire of 1777 and has undergone many changes. The beautiful veranda and balcony were built in the 1920s and the building bears traces from both the 1600s and the 1800s.

10 KR-HMN'S CHURCH

A neo-gothic gem

Östra Staketgatan. Built 1858.

One of Sweden's finest examples of neo-gothic architecture designed by Carl Georg Brunius. The church has changed through the years but has retained its unique character. Gustaf Fröding's father and one of his sisters lie buried by this church.

11 FRÖDINGGÅRDEN

Gustaf Fröding's childhood home

Nya Kyrkogatan 5.

Frödinggården was the home of Gustaf Fröding, (one of Sweden's most loved poets), and his family between 1868 and 1882. The young Gustaf lived here in a small attic flat, where he probably wrote his

first poems. Between the floorboards small pieces of paper have been found written by his schoolboy hand, on which he wrote some simple lines of verse. The Fröding family moved to Kristinehamn in 1867, and in 1872 Gustaf's father, lieutenant Ferdinand Fröding, bought the house after having inherited money. Fröding doesn't directly mention Kristinehamn in his poems, but many believe that the town and its inhabitants inspired his work.

12 STADSHOTELLET

A gem of neo-renaissance architecture

Kungsgatan 27. Built 1878.

In the hotel Kristinasalen was one of the country's foremost banqueting halls of its day. The ceiling is described by those who know, as neo-renaissance. Practically every detail is typically renaissance. When you study the walls and ceiling you notice many beautiful aspects. The ceiling paintings are partly executed in oils, for example the portraits that are set into the ceiling including the two daughters of restaurant keeper Carl August Wadsten.

THE PICASSO SCULPTURE

On the shore of Lake Vänern in Kristinehamn stands the world's largest sculpture by Pablo Picasso. The area, with its boating, cafés, restaurants, hiking trails, and lakeside promenade, is popular all year round.

The construction of the sculpture was carried out by the Norwegian artist Carl Nesjar, entirely according to Pablo Picasso's instructions.

Diana Widmaier Picasso is a grandchild of Pablo Picasso. She visited the Picasso sculpture on its 50th anniversary and stated:

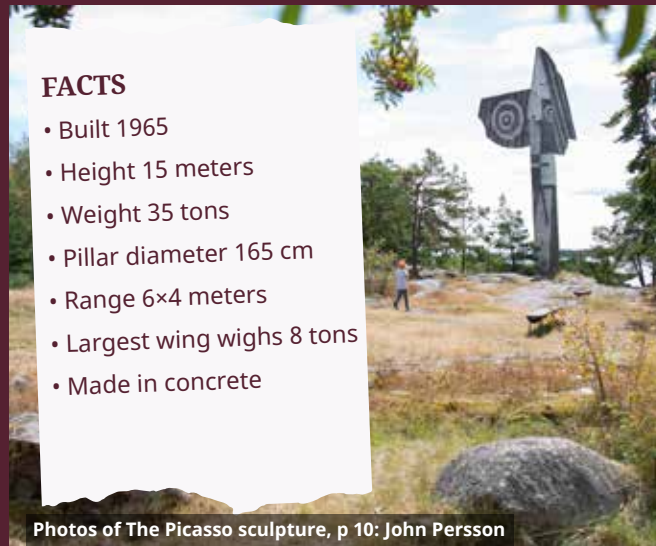
"This is exactly how my grandfather wanted it."

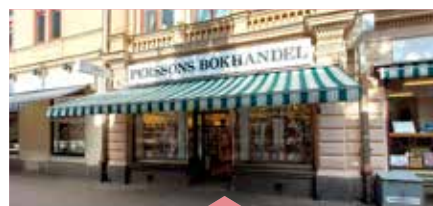

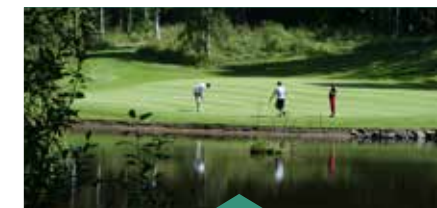

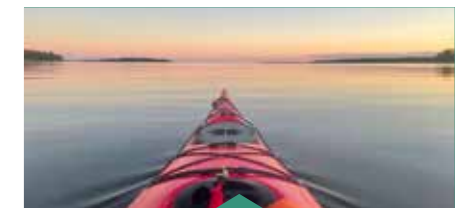

BOAT 96 - TO ISLANDS ALVÖN & LÅNGÖN

Three days a week (July 25th – Aug 17th) a tour boat sets out for the islands of Alvön and Långön. The boat trip departs four times a day from Vålösundsbyruggan. Jump off at an island or take an hour and 45-minute long round trip.

ALVÖN



One of the most beautiful rock islands with many smoothly moulded rocks facing west. One small sandy beach. A trail takes you to the rocks on the island's western side, where you can swim with a view of Vänern's unbroken horizon *

LÅNGÖN



Explore the trails that take you to the other side of the island, where there is a good chance of finding your own rock on which to sunbathe. Next to the tour boat jetty there is a small child-friendly sandy beach, wind break and firepit. *



BOAT 97, TO ISLANDS VÅLÖN & KALVÖN

All weekdays (June 23rd – Aug 10th and weekends 16th – 17th and 23rd – 24th August) you can go to Vålön island with the wooden boat Stöten. The trip takes 10 minutes and departs from Vålösundsbyruggan. Vålön is connected by bridges to Kalvön and Sibberön and a hiking trail lets you explore them all. Twice a day the boat also stops at Kalvön.

VÅLÖN



A paradise for families; sandy beaches, woodlands, blueberries, raspberries, and the hiking trail Tre öars led (4 km one way).

KALVÖN



When you step onto the connecting bridge between Vålön and Kalvön you'll have an open view of the lake and islands all around. You may pitch a tent in designated spots. *

SIBBERÖN



A simple wooden cottage can be used to spend the night but cannot be booked in advance. The views are breathtaking, especially from the southernmost points of the island. Look for the white-tailed eagle. *

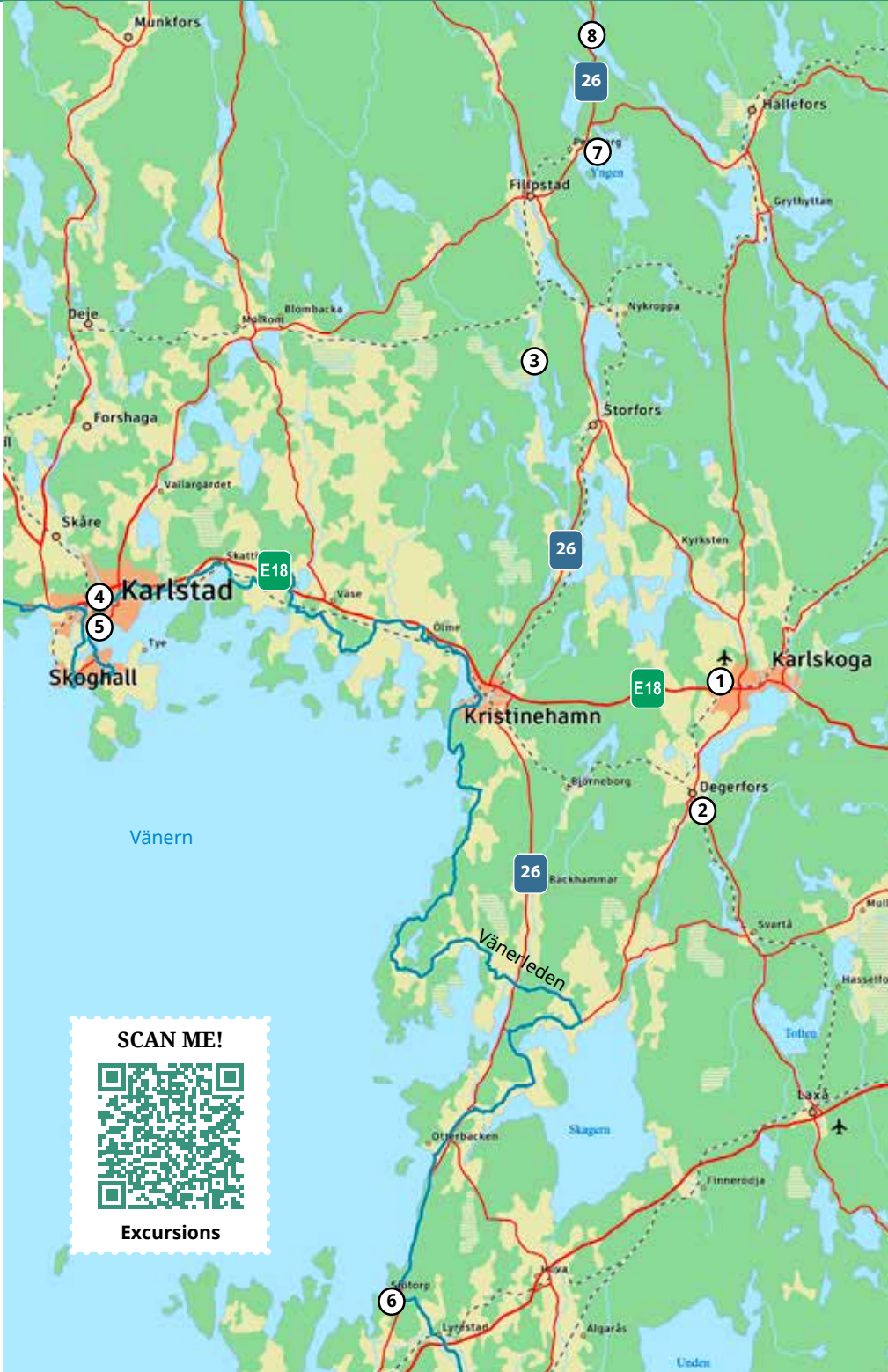
